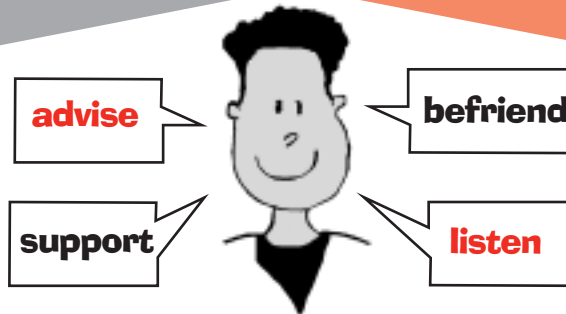

Independent Visitors

Hi

Independent visitors are for children and young people who haven't had any regular family contact for a long time. They're there to advise, befriend and support young people in the 'looked after' system. They are not social workers; they are independent which means they are not part of social services.

The Childrens' Act says that "as I am not in regular contact with my family I can have an independent visitor if I want one".

You can chat about anything you like with your independent visitor and it'll be kept confidential between yourselves, unless the independent visitor is worried about your safety or someone else's, then they would have to check it out with your social worker.
